APPLICATION CHECKLIST

To successfully apply to the program, applicants must include:



ONLINE APPLICATION

Complete the online application for the Georgetown Graduate School of Arts and Sciences.



CURRICULUM VITAE (CV)

Upload a resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV) with your online application.



RECOMMENDATIONS

Submit 3 recommendations. At least one should be from an academic source and at least one from a work-related source.



OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Submit official transcripts of ALL work beyond secondary school. International applicants who attend institutions outside of the US are encouraged to submit transcripts in the form of World Education Services (WES) ICAP evaluations.



ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS (INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)

Submit an official Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) score OR an official International English Language Testing System (IELTS) score.



ACADEMIC STATEMENT

Upload an academic statement that explains why MLD is the program for you. The maximum length is 500 words.

WRITING SAMPLE

Upload a writing sample that reflects your ability to handle high-level academic writing and produce original critical analysis.
